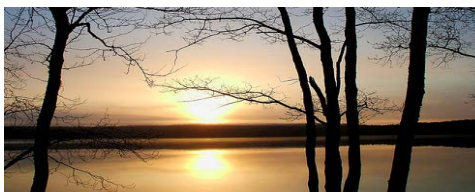

March 2 - "Why the Bible?"

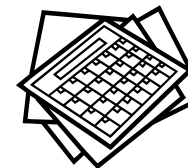
March 9 - "Why Pray?"

# 2008 Nominations

## Request for recommendations for the Board of Elders:

Under Article 8.06 (b) (I) and (II) of the by-laws, the Board of Elders is inviting recommendations from church members for potential candidates for the Board of Elders.

Please note:

Under Article 8.05 of the By-laws, Board members are elected for a three-year term with approximately one-third of the terms expiring each year. Also, a board member is eligible to serve two consecutive three-year terms after which the board member will be ineligible to serve on the board for a minimum of one year. Because 2007 was the first year of operation under our new by-laws, and in order to comply with this by-law, the Board agreed to the following breakdown of terms for the elders:

Stephane Godbout, Debbie McPherson and Bruce Preston have now served one year of a three-year term. Jack Stultz, Shelley Lipscombe, and Peter Atkinson have served one year of a two-year term. Bryan Taylor and Travis Tait have served one year of a one-year term.

We are now requesting recommendations for the two positions which are expiring this year, these positions are for a three year term. Please note that both Bryan and Travis are prepared to let their names stand for these positions.

You can submit suggestions by picking up an information packet from the office, and submitting your recommendation for consideration to Jack Stultz, through the church office, no later than February 24. If you have any questions with regard to nominations for the Board of Elders, please feel free to ask any of the Elders.
